



GLOSS PVA PROTECTIVE FILM

REMOVAL OF THE FACTORY APPLIED PROTECTIVE FILM FROM GLOSS FINISHED LOUDSPEAKERS [REV-B]

Zu gloss loudspeakers are sprayed with a clear, protective and water soluble PVA film. Because the film is thin and clear, you may not realize it's there, which also means you will be putting up with less than amazing finish quality. Once you get your loudspeakers positioned, please take ten or so minutes per speaker and remove this film.

THE WORK

1. Reinstall the protective full-range driver covers, if you've taken them off.
2. Work one loudspeaker at a time and avoid excessive overspray. Generously spritz the complete loudspeaker finish with clean, warm tap water or Meguiar's® M34 Mirror Glaze™ Final Inspection*. If it's beading and running off, you are spraying too much, although you want to be more liberal than typical mist-on and wipe. Avoid excessively wetting the tweeter, full-range driver and nameplate. A bit of mist is no big deal, but you don't want to pool liquid on them. Let stand for a minute or two so it can loosen the film. Take this time and start the next step.
3. Moisten and wring out a clean cotton or microfiber hand towel. The towel should be damp, but not dripping. We include one microfiber towel with each loudspeaker, so you will have two. Use one for removal of the PVA and the other for final wipe down and future dusting and cleaning.
4. Use the damp towel to finish breaking down and wiping off the PVA film from the loudspeaker. Work top to bottom and use long strokes. You will notice the film liquefying, revealing the mirror-like finish beneath.
5. Rinse the cloth used to remove the bulk of the PVA, wring it out and repeat the process on the other loudspeaker.
6. Your loudspeaker are nearly clean, but likely there are a few splotches of PVA that were overlooked. With a clean cloth (damp or dry) mist and wipe each loudspeaker again, this time working one side at a time and promptly wiping after misting. Water, Meguiar's Final Inspection or Zu Clean-N-Shine can be used for this second round of initial cleaning.
7. They should now glow and whisper softly (or loudly) to your immortality. Even so, you can wheedle an even deeper shin if you like. For a third and last round, working one panel at a time, mist and promptly wipe using Zu Clean-N-Shine.
